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## **Demolition Derby General Rules**

A Demolition Derby is designed and promoted as an unusual spectator attraction and in the interest of safety, anyone entering is subject to the following rules and regulations as hereby set forth by Hagerstown Speedway, Inc. upon where you are competing.

- A) All Drivers must fill out an application before taking part in an event and register at the pit gate.
- B) Hagerstown Speedway reserves the right to approve or reject any and all applications.
- C) Only drivers, owners, mechanics, etc., that sign the insurance release will be permitted in the pit area.
- D) Members of the Demolition Derby are not employees of Hagerstown Speedway, but are independent contractors.

### **SAFETY AND CAR SPECIFICATIONS**

- A) All drivers must wear an approved safety helmet. Safety belts are required.
- B) No special bumpers or reinforcements will be allowed, OEM or factory style bumpers only
- C) All doors must be securely fastened shut, but cannot be spot welded. They must be completely shut with solid welding. Trunks must be empty.
- D) All glass must be removed including front and rear windshields, and all door windows, and head and tail lights.
- E) All outside chrome except grill and front and rear bumpers must be removed.
- F) One battery only allowed. Battery may be mounted in drivers compartment, but must be covered and secured.

G) Gas tank may be remounted in the area behind the back seat over the rear end. A firewall must be installed when gas tank is remounted. Optional tanks; (6) six gallon Outboard Motor tank, (5) five gallon Army Surplus Gerry Cans, or the equivalent. Gas line must run under the floor board.

H) Radiator must be functional (with water) and in original position, fan may be removed.

I) Generators may be disconnected and removed if desired.

J) Car number must be painted on both front doors and on the roof. This is necessary so the judges can see the numbers from above. Letters should be 18 inches high. No obscene words may be painted on the cars.

K) Fuel: Gasoline only. NO ALCOHOL.

### **COMPETITION**

1) No deliberate hitting on the driver's side door and no playing possum. Keep your car moving or you may be disqualified.

2) Prior to the Derby, a meeting will be held and the ground rules will be explained.

3) All cars must be removed following the Demolition Derby. If the owner does not want the vehicle, the title must be turned over to the producer.

4) Absolutely no drinking of alcoholic beverages will be tolerated by; Driver Mechanics, or Officials of the Derby immediately prior to, or during the Derby. Violators will be escorted off the grounds.

5) Any driver who gets out of his car for any reason after the start of the Derby, will be out. Any car that is turned over will be out.

6) No cars will be allowed to enter the Derby after the starting flag has been dropped. All cars must be on the track and in line prior to the start of the event.

### **8 CYLINDER DEMOLITION DERBY RULES**

GENERAL RULES APPLY

A) Any American-Made, Hard Top car or automobile is allowed, station wagons included. No commercial type vehicles allowed. **No Chrysler Imperials or Rancheros Allowed.**

### **6 CYLINDER DEMOLITION DERBY RULES**

GENERAL RULES APPLY

A) Any 6-cylinder hard top car or automobile is allowed. No commercial type vehicles allowed. Minivans and small trucks are permitted

## **4 CYLINDER DEMOLITION DERBY RULES**

GENERAL RULES APPLY

A) Any 4-cylinder, front wheel drive, hard top car or automobile is allowed. No commercial type vehicles allowed. No Mini-vans or small trucks.
